

**FROM FR. MARK:**

This coming Wednesday, February 17 is Ash Wednesday, a Day of Fast and Abstinence. All Catholics 14 and over are obliged to abstain from meat and Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. Fasting means one full meal and, if necessary, two other small meals that together are less than a meal. We'll have Mass with Distribution of Ashes at 6:30 am, 9:00 am, 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm (Spanish). We also have a Word Service with Distribution of Ashes at 12:00 noon.

The arrival of Lent also means that we will resume our Lenten Friday night stations of the cross with mass. We'll pray the stations of the Cross this Friday night, Feb 19 at 5:30 pm followed immediately by mass.

This weekend I ask each parishioner to renew his or her financial stewardship to the parish for the coming year. We are deeply grateful to each household for your sharing of treasure. I ask you to consider a tithe. We recommend a gift of 5% of our income to the parish, 4% to other charities, and 1% to the *Archbishop's Call to Share*.

I also invite you to learn more about the Rice Bowl Program that will be available this Lent. It is a great way for the whole family to practice prayer, fasting, and the giving of alms.

We welcome Fr. David Armando Garavito to Holy Cross! Fr. David is from Fr. Liborio's Diocese of Zipaquirá, Colombia. Fr. will be beginning his studies in English at Donnelly College and we will introduce him to the English masses soon.

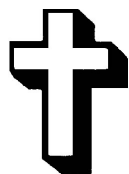

Our work concentrates on helping families through the Dominican Center for Woman or A.C.T.S. with repairs, and helping the Senior population through the Milwaukee Center for Independence and the Interfaith Senior Center. One group also spends a week helping Repairers of the Breach, an outreach ministry to the homeless.

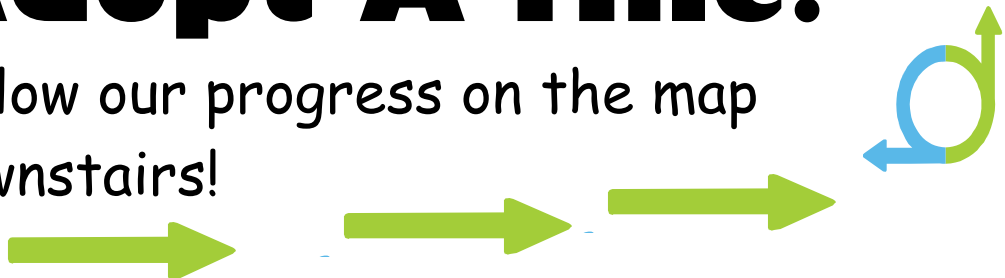
