Dear Parishioners,

The saying goes, “To Jesus through Mary.” It tells us that we can become closer to Jesus by our devotion to His Mother. A recent addition to our parish property graphically illustrates that point. In our meditation garden, there stands a statue of the Blessed Virgin, as Our Lady of Guadalupe. Behind it, a group of Boy Scouts, led by Evan Meyers, has constructed a labyrinth as an Eagle Scout project. At the center of the labyrinth there lies a cross, the symbol of Jesus; sacrifice. That is our goal. To Jesus through Mary. During the Middle Ages, many churches made labyrinths to serve as an aid for prayer and meditation. The labyrinth can help us see our lives as a journey of faith, a kind of pilgrimage. Slowly walking on it can clear our minds and encourage us to focus on God. As St. Augustine said, “Solvitur ambulando, It is solved by walking.”

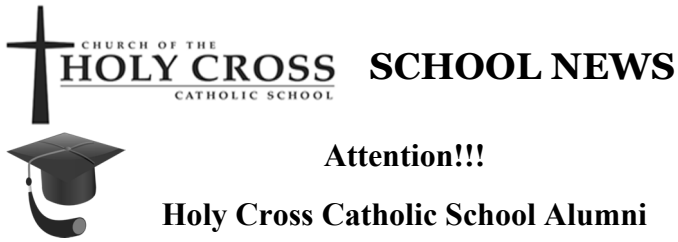

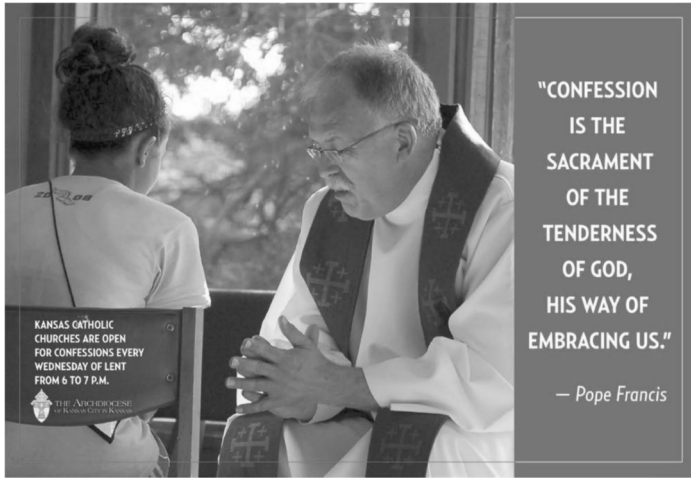

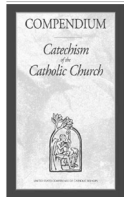

Catechism Corner

Why is faith a personal act, and at the same time ecclesial?

Faith is a personal act insofar as it is the free response of the human person to God who reveals himself. But at the same time it is an ecclesial act which expresses itself in the proclamation, "We believe". It is in fact the Church that believes: and thus by the grace of the Holy Spirit precedes, engenders and nourishes the faith of each Christian. For this reason the Church is Mother and Teacher. "No one can have God as Father who does not have the Church as Mother." (St. Cyprian) Further reading: CCC 166-169, 181 *Excerpt are from the Compendium of the CCC.*

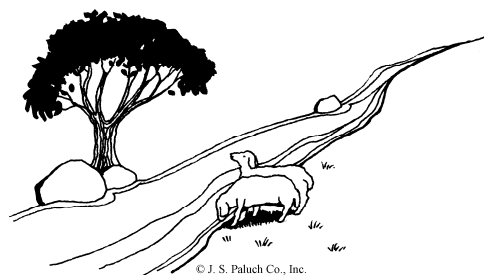
Estimados Feligreses,

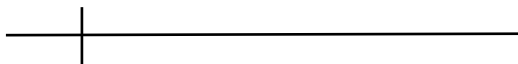


