Stewardship Reflection April 2, 2017

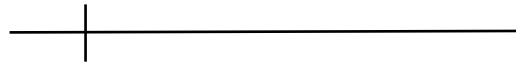
So Martha and Mary sent a message to Jesus, "Lord, he whom you love is ill." John 11:3
