The full July 2017 - June 2018 budget will be published soon along with our long term financial plan developed last year. A key component of this plan is starting with a balanced budget and over \$300k of expenses have been reduced at both the church and school in the upcoming fiscal year towards that end. While this has been very challenging, the Holy Cross leadership is firmly committed to a sustainable financial path forward so we as a community can continue our very important mission into the future. 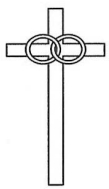
Catechism Corner

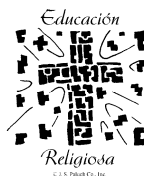


CONFERENCIA SOBRE MATRIMONIO Y FAMILIA

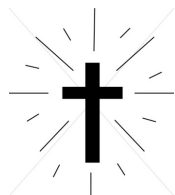


