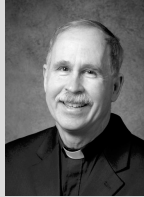

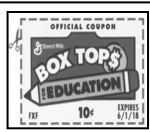
**Revised Scrip Sheet**

**Protecting God’s Children—VIRTUS Training**

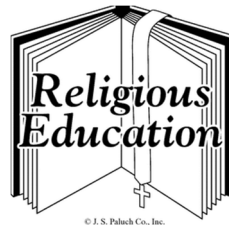


All Church employees and volunteers who have substantial contact with children and teens are required to attend VIRTUS training. An upcoming session

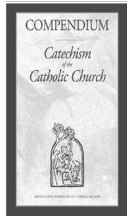

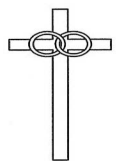


## Catechism Corner

This weekend, St. Paul tells us that our “spiritual worship” consists of offering our “bodies as a living sacrifice.” We live in a world that loves to separate “spirit” and “body,” but an integration of the two has always been the Church’s understanding of what it means to be human!

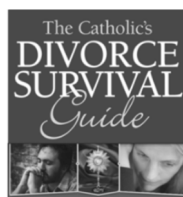
As married couples, we make this worship to God evident when we lovingly:

- Speak affirmation and forgiveness when it’s difficult
- Intentionally offer physical affection
- Welcome children
- Trust our spouse with our feelings
- Listen attentively to our spouse

## Stewardship Reflection *September 3, 2017*

In today’s Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples, “Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.” At the end of the reading Jesus suggests there is great hope in the cross. Today’s followers of Christ recognize they are stewards of his entire legacy, including his cross and that through their mutual sacrifices God’s glory is revealed. They don’t live their lives in Christ only when it is convenient for them. They make a decision to take up their cross and carry it, no matter what the cost is to themselves.

Reflect this week on the cross you bear in order to reveal God’s glory. How do you embrace that cross? How, at times, do you shirk that cross when it is not convenient?
