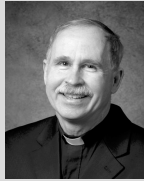

Revised Scrip Sheet

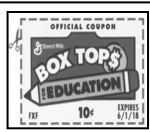


The Scrip sheet has been revised to make it easier to find what you need.

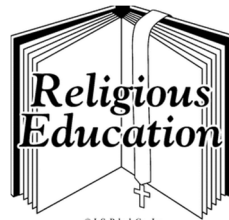

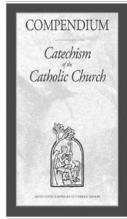

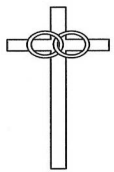


Catechism Corner

In the stress of everyday life, we can feel isolated or disconnected from our spouse or God. One simple thing we can do to recover that connection and overcome the isolation is to simply pray with our spouse for our marriage and our children. Praying together doesn't guarantee our desired outcome, but it does always:

- Require vulnerability, and therefore bring us closer to our spouse
- Remind us that we have an all-powerful Father who only wants what is best for us
- Open us up to possibilities we did not see before

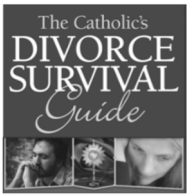

In the near future all interested families in our parish will be contacted by a cemetery representative and be given the important information.



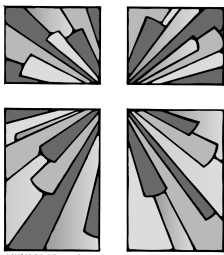

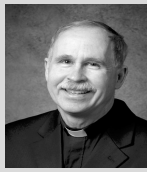
