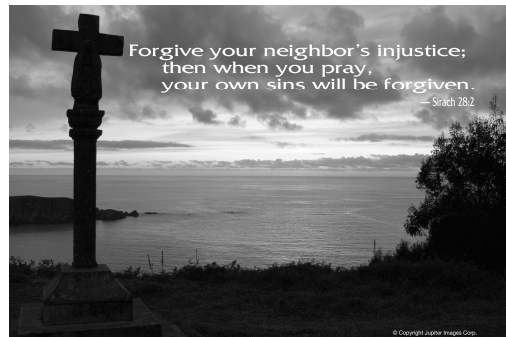

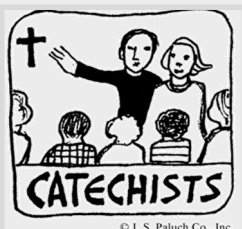

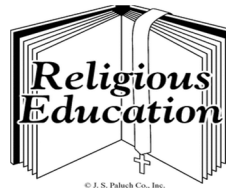


All Church employees and volunteers who have substantial contact with children and teens are required to attend VIRTUS training. An upcoming session

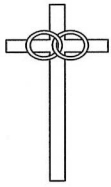

Here are a few hints to avoid this:

- While times are good, decide on a process for how you will handle hurts
- Consider a letter-writing process so you are less likely to say things you don't mean
- Commit to deal with hurts promptly so that they don't fester, and lovingly, so you don't cause more hurt

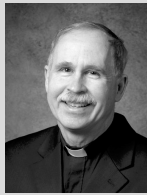

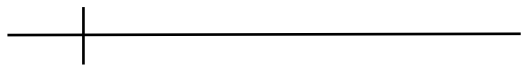
