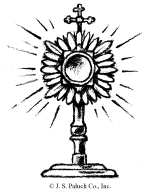

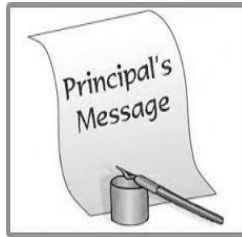

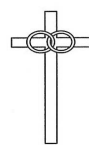

Are you prepared?

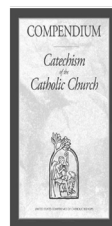
