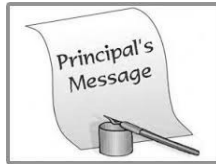

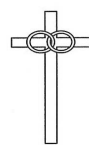
Knights of Columbus donation

Marriage Minute



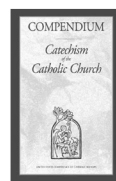
Have you storm proofed your marriage?
