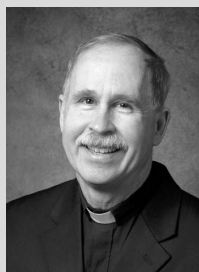

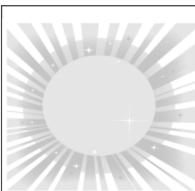


Bible study, book of Genesis

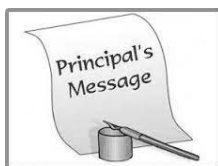

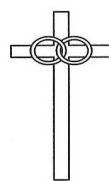


**Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

The same consistent attention is needed for our spouse if our marriage is to be healthy. One need in marriage, especially for wives, is to be heard.

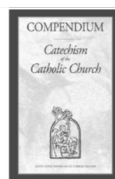
We would do well to have the disposition of Samuel in this weekend's readings when he tells God, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening!"
