Catechism Corner

After the first sin, what did God do?

After the first sin the world was inundated with sin but God did not abandon man to the power of death.

Rather, he foretold in a mysterious way in the "Protoevangelium" (Genesis 3:15) that evil would be conquered and that man would be lifted up from his fall. This was the first proclamation of the Messiah and Redeemer. Therefore, the fall would be called in the future a "happy fault" because it "gained for us so great a Redeemer" (Liturgy of the Easter Vigil) Further reading: CCC 410-412, 420
