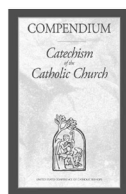
Stewardship Reflection *January 28, 2018*

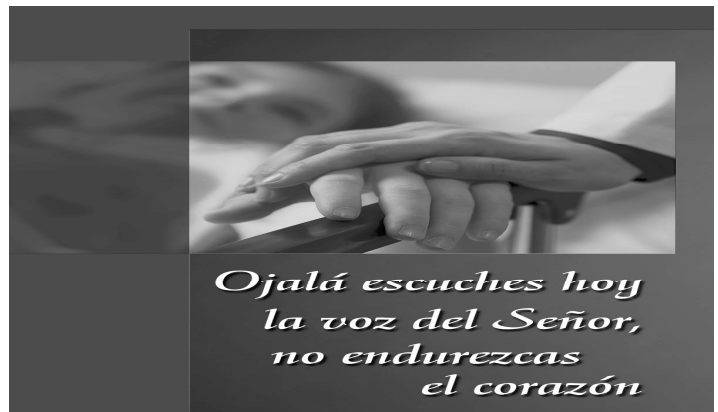
