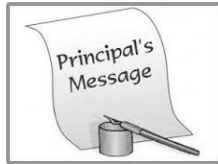

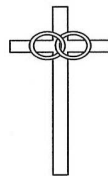

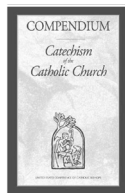
Stewardship Reflection February 4, 2018
