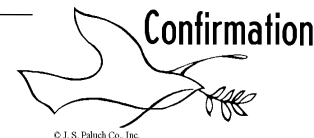
Religious Education This Week

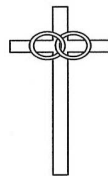

Like the lepers, the problems themselves seem so much bigger when faced alone. When Jesus healed the lepers, he not only ended their physical suffering, but invited them back into community. 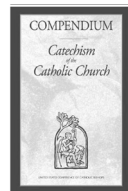

Stewardship Reflection February 11, 2018

"Brothers and sisters, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." - 1 Corinthians 10:31

Do a quick check of your priorities. Where does God rank in that list? If He's not first, you have some work to do. Putting God first in everything helps us from putting other "gods" (like our pride and ego, money and possessions to name a few) before God. Before making a decision, ask yourself Am I going this for the glory of God or for the glory of me?

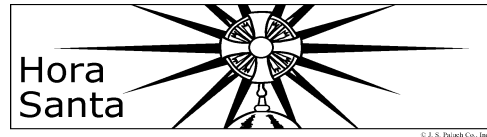
