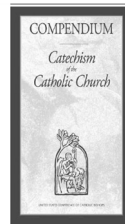
Stewardship Reflection

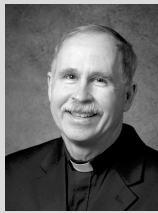
