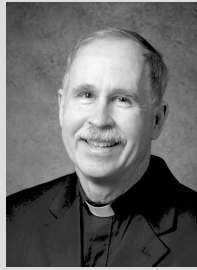

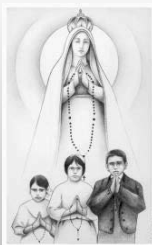


Holy Hour to Pray for Vocations

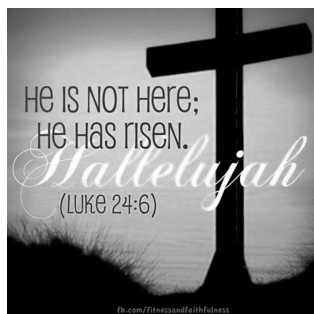

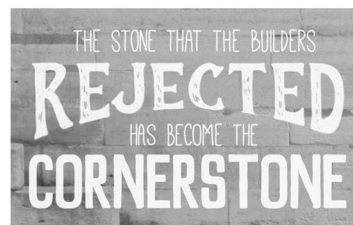


Marriage Minute

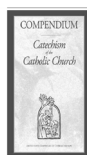

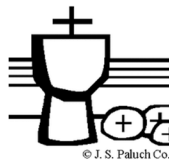

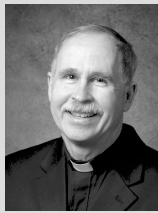
