Famous Last Words

Before ascending into heaven, Jesus told his disciples to “Go out into all the world and tell the Good News.” As married couples, we have a very specific piece of good news to proclaim: that lifelong love is possible! 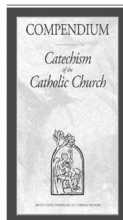

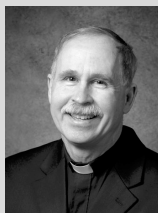
