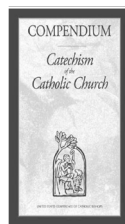
Stewardship Reflection

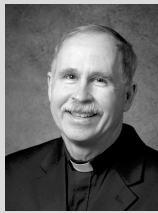

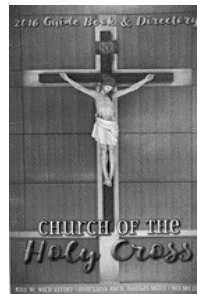
