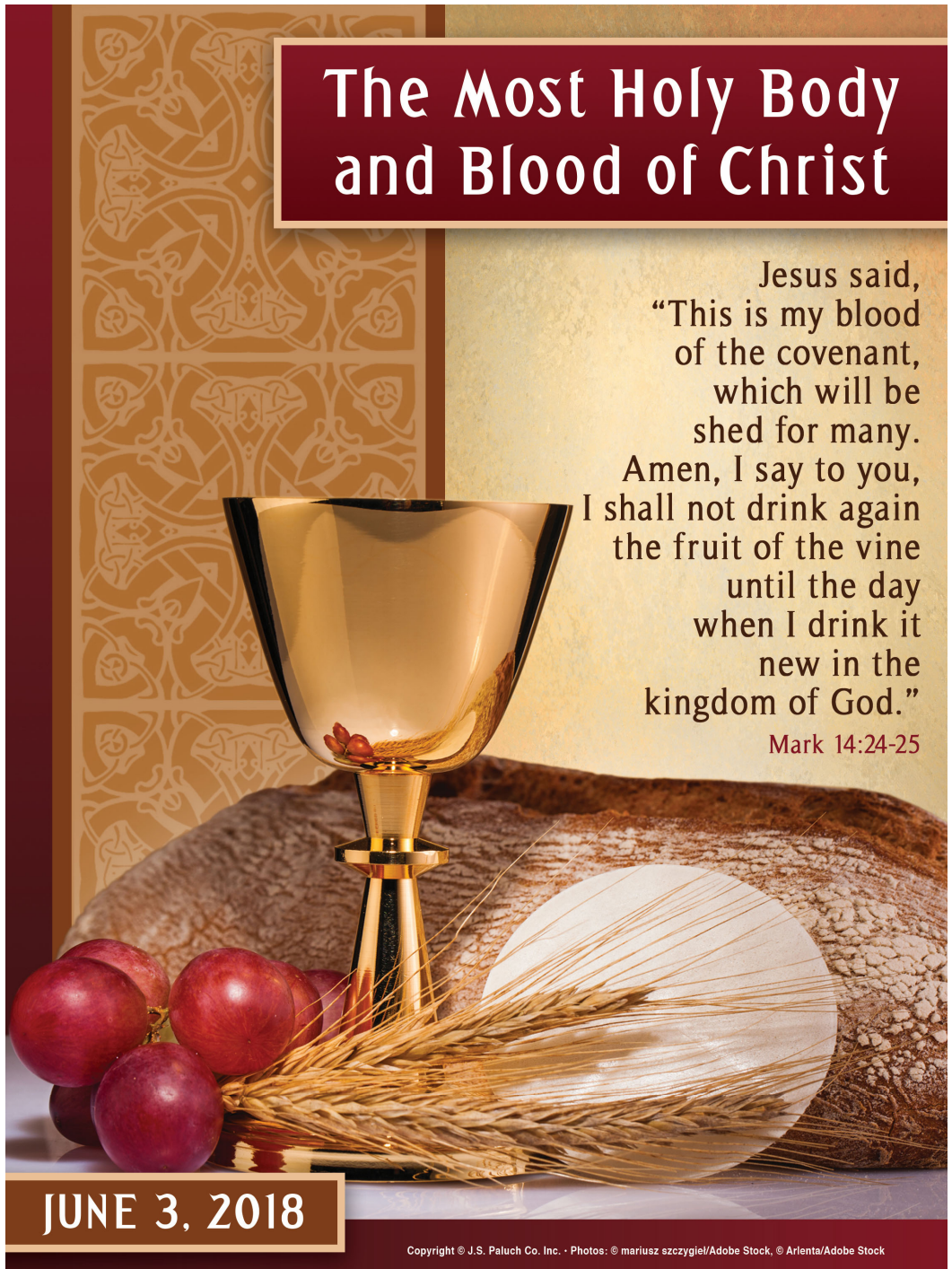

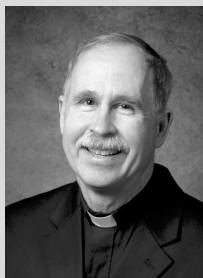

Dear Parishioners,

Occasionally, someone will ask why we don't go to the tabernacle when we start to distribute Holy Communion at Mass. There is a simple reason for that. As the Pastoral Patterns points out, "The Church is clear that we should be receiving the bread and wine consecrated during the Mass at which we celebrate. Turning to the tabernacle should only be done as a last resort, when all the Eucharistic bread consecrated at the given Mass has been consumed." The article also quotes the General Instruction on the Roman Missal 85, that the faithful attending Mass should "receive the Lord's Body from hosts consecrated at the same Mass." When this happens, we emphasize the connection between our celebration of the Eucharist and the sacrament that we receive.

Notes from the Parish Business Manager

Large facilities require continual maintenance and we've recently had some larger capital expenses. After 19 years, the school gym heating and cooling roof top unit has quit and is being replaced at a cost of \$26,378. We also recently spent approximately \$3,000 to have the church downspouts piped away from the north and south ends of the building as water was entering the basement in these areas. This cost would have been much higher except for the generous time of volunteers that helped. More waterproofing is needed along the church north wall foundation but the runouts have already made a big difference.

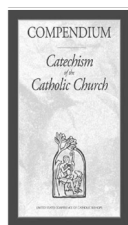
- Making physical affection and intimacy an important part of our lives

Therefore, when the Gospels speak of the "brothers and sisters of Jesus", they are talking about the close relations of Jesus, according to the way of speaking used in Sacred Scripture. 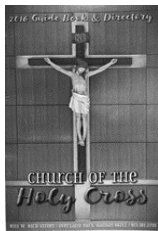

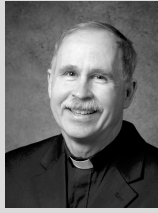

Estimados Feligreses,

Ocasionalmente, alguien preguntará por que no vamos al tabernáculo cuando comenzamos a distribuir la Sagrada Comunión en la Misa. Hay una razón simple para esa pregunta. Como lo señalan las Palabras Pastorales, “La Iglesia tiene claro que deberíamos recibir el pan y el vino consagrados durante la Misa que celebramos. El volverse al tabernáculo debería hacerse solo como último recurso, cuando todo el pan Eucarístico consagrado en esa Misa ha sido consumido.” El artículo también cita la Instrucción General sobre el Misal Romano 85, según la cual los fieles que asisten a la Misa deben “recibir el Cuerpo del Señor de las hostias consagradas en la misma Misa.” Cuando esto sucede, enfatizamos la conexión entre nuestra celebración de la Eucaristía y el sacramento que recibimos.
