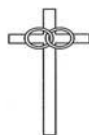

O LORD, from my youth.*

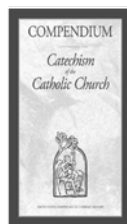
Stewardship Reflection

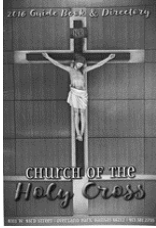
Catechism Corner


