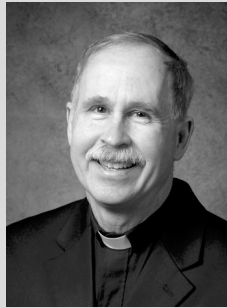

Sat. Sept 8 beginning at 4:00 pm



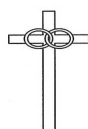

Stewardship Reflection

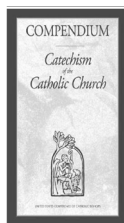

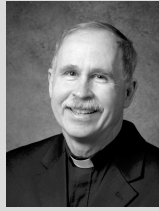
