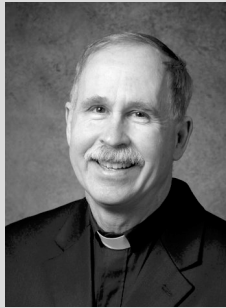

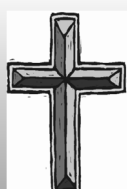

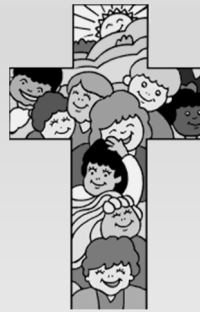

**3rd grade news**

The third graders are off and running this school year! They are learning to be responsible by filling out their Daily Assignment Notebook. They celebrated Mexican Independence Day by studying about Father Miguel Hidalgo and his speech called "The Cry of Dolores". They also read about Tres Leches Cake (three milk cake) which they made and enjoyed eating in class. Viva Mexico! 3rd graders are working on their first book report "Book in a Box" and they will present their book to the class. They have been practicing place value in Math by rounding, adding/subtracting, learning the properties of addition (Commutative, Associative, and Identity). In Science, they have started investigating with magnetism. In Social Studies, they are learning about their place in the world (city, state, country, continent). Finally, in Religion, 3rd graders learned all about the 5 types of prayer and wrote their own prayers to be read over the intercom. They are also getting ready to lead a primary mass in the month of October.

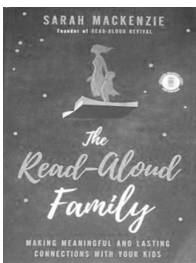

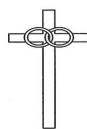

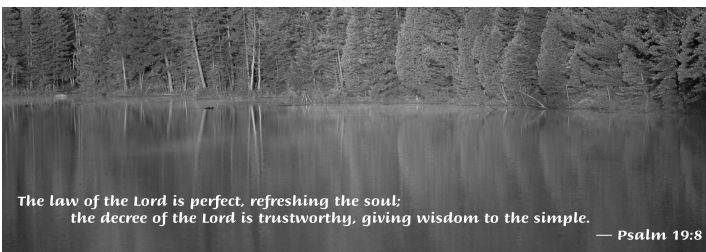
### **Marriage Minute**

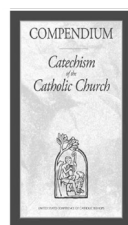

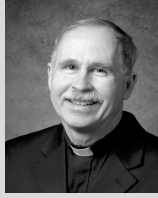


### **Catechism Corner**

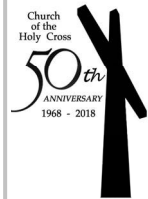

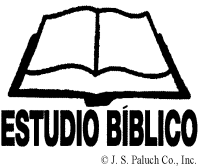


