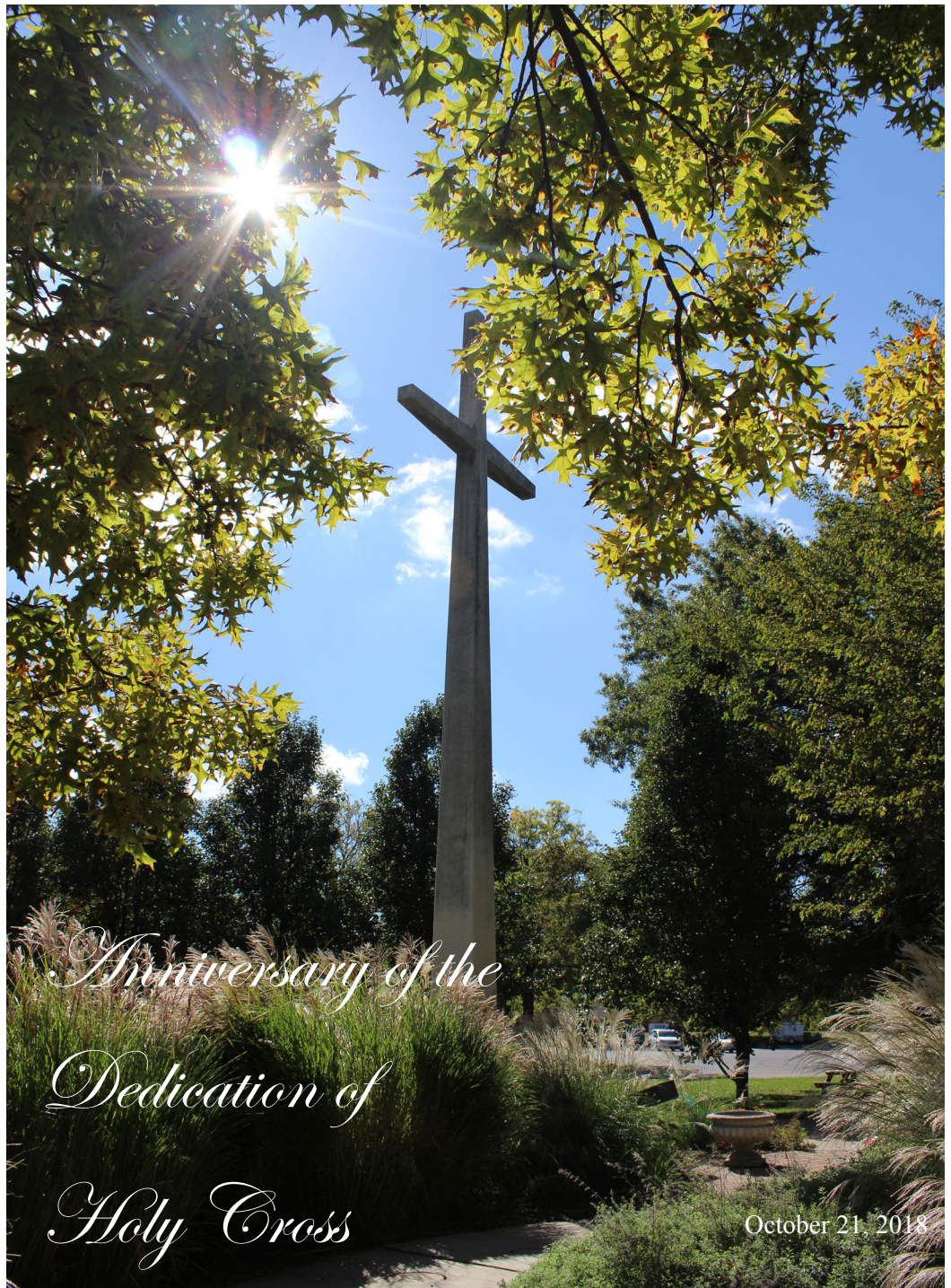

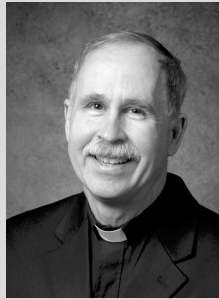

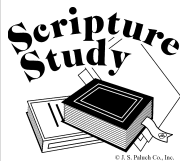

This week our 8th graders had their annual retreat! What a great time for our 8th grade students. So many things change for them this year, they are selecting the right high school, they are working hard to learn all they need to learn as 8th graders and they are preparing to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit through Confirmation!

6th grade news

Sixth grade has been working very hard in school. We have been discussing the Old Testament in Social Studies and Religion. We have infused our faith in Social Studies while learning about Ancient Mesopotamia and the Hebrew kings, David and Solomon. We learned about our four faith fathers (patriarchs) and how they were a huge impact within the Fertile Crescent. We discussed in deeper detail about Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Joseph. We will continue learning about ancient civilizations in Social Studies and comparing that time period to some important leaders in the bible. In ELA we have just finished Hatchet and will be starting our Hatchet book unit project! The 6th graders' book reports looked awesome! In science we have been working on the nervous system. In math the students have been working on fractions and decimals. The sixth graders will continue to grow with perseverance, prayer, and faith.

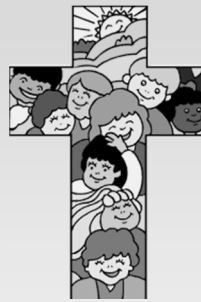

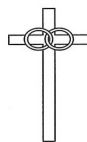

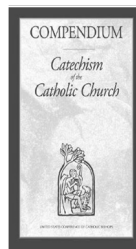
Stewardship Reflection

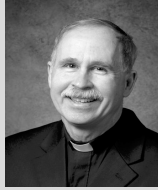


How did Jesus conduct himself in regard to the Law of Israel?

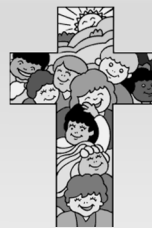


