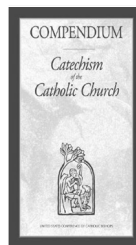
Stewardship Reflection

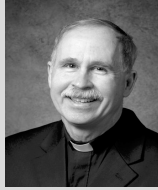
Catechism Corner


