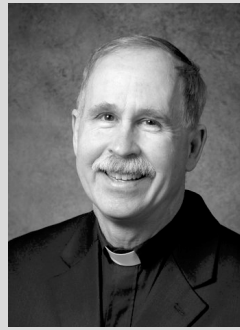

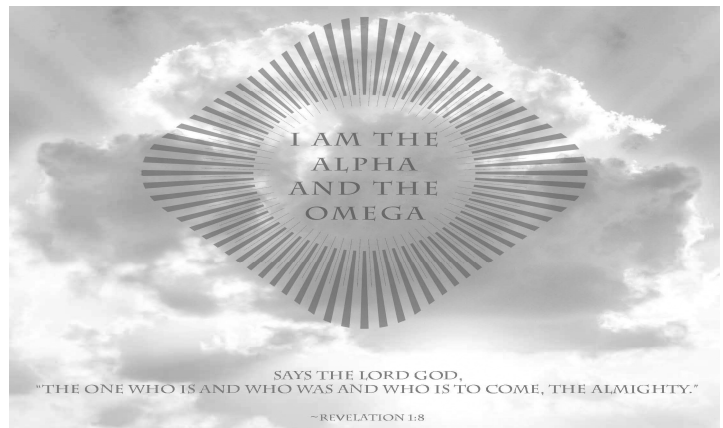

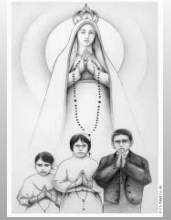

The beauty is found within our Kindergarten classroom each day as they enter through our classroom doors. These little children see the beauty and wonderment that the good Lord has provided in this world around us. It is truly an amazing experience to watch them learn and grow into faith-filled children.

As the season of Advent approaches, we will teach the Truth through the stories of the Nativity and discover how Angels are messengers and gifts from God. Understanding that each person is a child of God and He made us in His image, we will go on an adventure around the world to learn about other cultures and how each celebrates the Christmas season. We will use our new global map skills to navigate us on our "flights" to other countries helping us understand and accept our differences. Displaying a sense of wonder about mathematical relationships, the students will challenge and expand their knowledge by starting to learn the addition and subtraction processes. In Science, the students will utilize their sense of inquiry and delight about the natural universe to explore forces of motion and how objects can be pushed or pulled to create movement. Each day we continuously practice and model what it means to be a Holy Cross student. We exhibit the virtues of Caring, Responsible, Obedience, Successful and Stewardship not only at school, but everywhere we go.

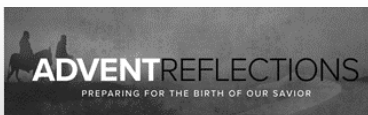

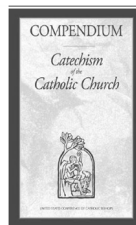

**Catechism Corner**

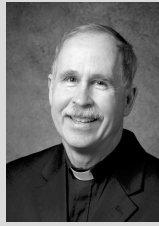


*In what way did Christ offer himself to the Father?*

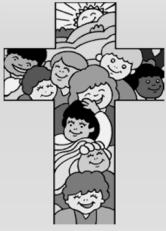
