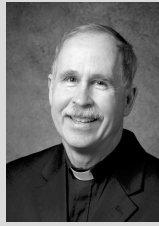
*What happened in the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane?*

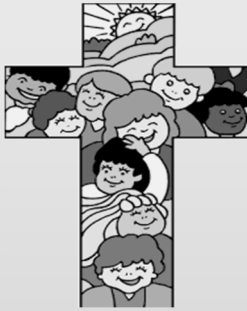
