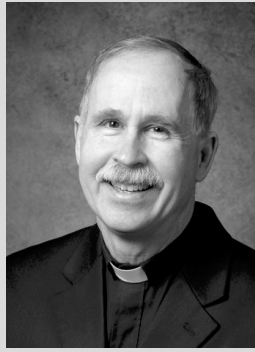

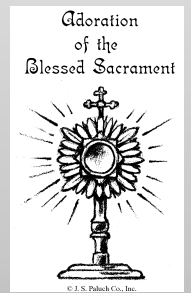

3rd Grade News

Holy Cross 3rd graders have been busy this quarter learning to multiply using groups, by skip counting, and making arrays. They are wrapped up in reading the “12 books of Christmas”, and writing letters to Baby Jesus.

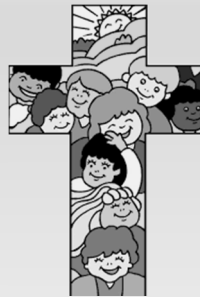
In Science, they have been learning all about biomes and habitats. When you walk through the 3rd grade hallways, you will see about 40 newly discovered desert animals created and made by the 3rd graders using various body parts of existing desert animals. A few of them are the Flying Stinging Lizard, the Heat Fox, the Flying Horned Lizard, and the Desert Horned Eagle. In Social Studies, 3rd graders traveled all over the world researching and learning about international cities, discovering traditional meals, holidays, and the A-Zs of their cities.

Our 3rd graders begin each day by writing in their gratitude journals, recording what they are thankful for, and thinking about their abundant blessings.

Job opportunity - Director of Music

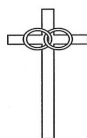

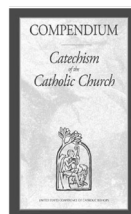
Stewardship Reflection

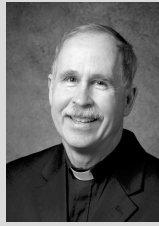


What are the results of the sacrifice of Christ on the cross?

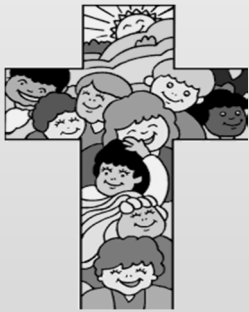
