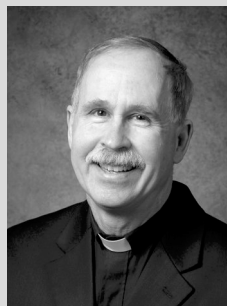

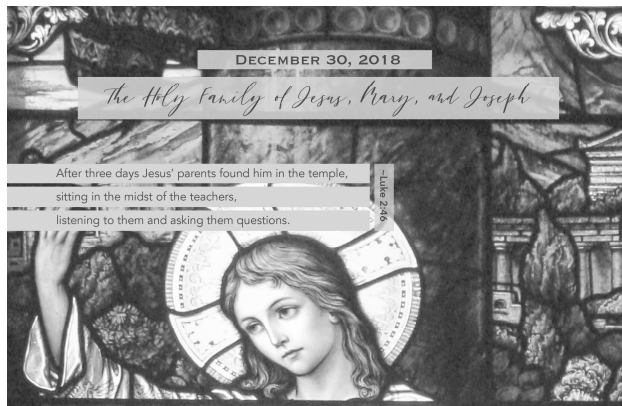

As we approach the new year, can the Scrip desk help you with a small resolution?

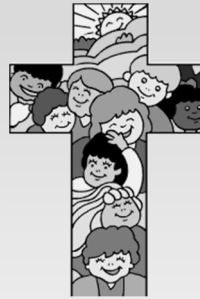
Try Scrip on a small basis and see how easy it is to use. Where do you shop for groceries or pharmacy needs? If you buy a \$25 card for CVS and/or Walgreen's, Holy Cross makes \$1.50 (or 6%) for each card bought. If you have a balance on the card, then it will appear on the bottom of your receipt, record it on the card, and you are ready for your next shopping outing. Simple math: \$1.50 earned **times** 12 months/year **times** 500 cards sold/people purchased = **\$9,000 [all of this goes to Holy Cross]**. So, grab a sheet from the clipboards after Mass and review the list for your weekly/monthly/seasonal shopping habits and use Scrip whenever you can knowing it's the easiest fundraising you'll ever do! Thank you for your prayers and support of the Holy Cross Scrip program.

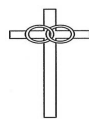

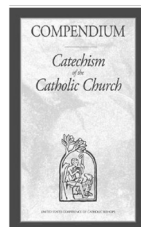
Stewardship Reflection

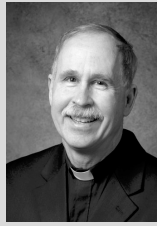

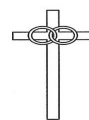
