
Stewardship Reflection January 6, 2019

What is original sin?

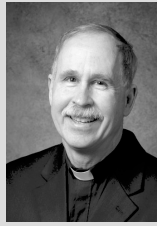


Original sin, in which all human beings are born, is the state of deprivation of original holiness and justice. It is a sin “contracted” by us not “committed”; it is a state of birth and not a personal act. Because of the original unity of all human beings, it is transmitted to the descendants of Adam “not by imitation, but by propagation.” This transmission remain a mystery which we cannot fully understand.

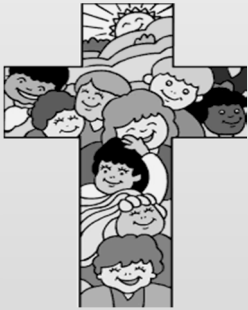

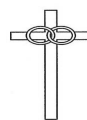
