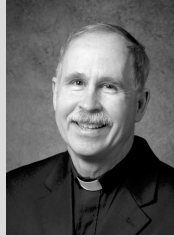

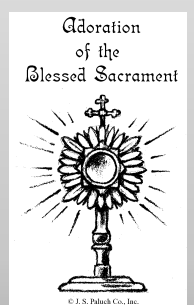

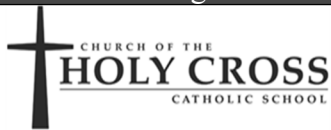

5th Grade News

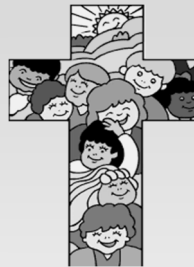
In the fifth grade, we have eagerly started reading the novel *Island of the Blue Dolphins*. With this novel, we will be exploring concepts such as inference, theme, and point of view. In science class, the students have been learning about God's creation of plants and the importance of photosynthesis. At the end of this unit, the students will get to grow their own vegetables hydroponically! We are continuing to spend our time in math on fractions and the operations that go with them. The 5th graders have learned that fractions are part of a whole, just like they are all parts of the whole mystical Body of Christ. In social studies the students are learning about how the teachings of Jesus Christ influenced the origin of this country and how it is founded on the principles of freedom, equality, and justice. Next in religion, we will begin exploring the mysteries of the rosary and how they tell Jesus' life story.

What if we approached our marriage in the same way these incredible athletes approached this game?



What is the condition of the risen body of Jesus?

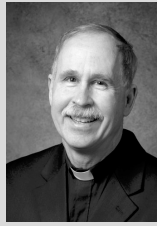
