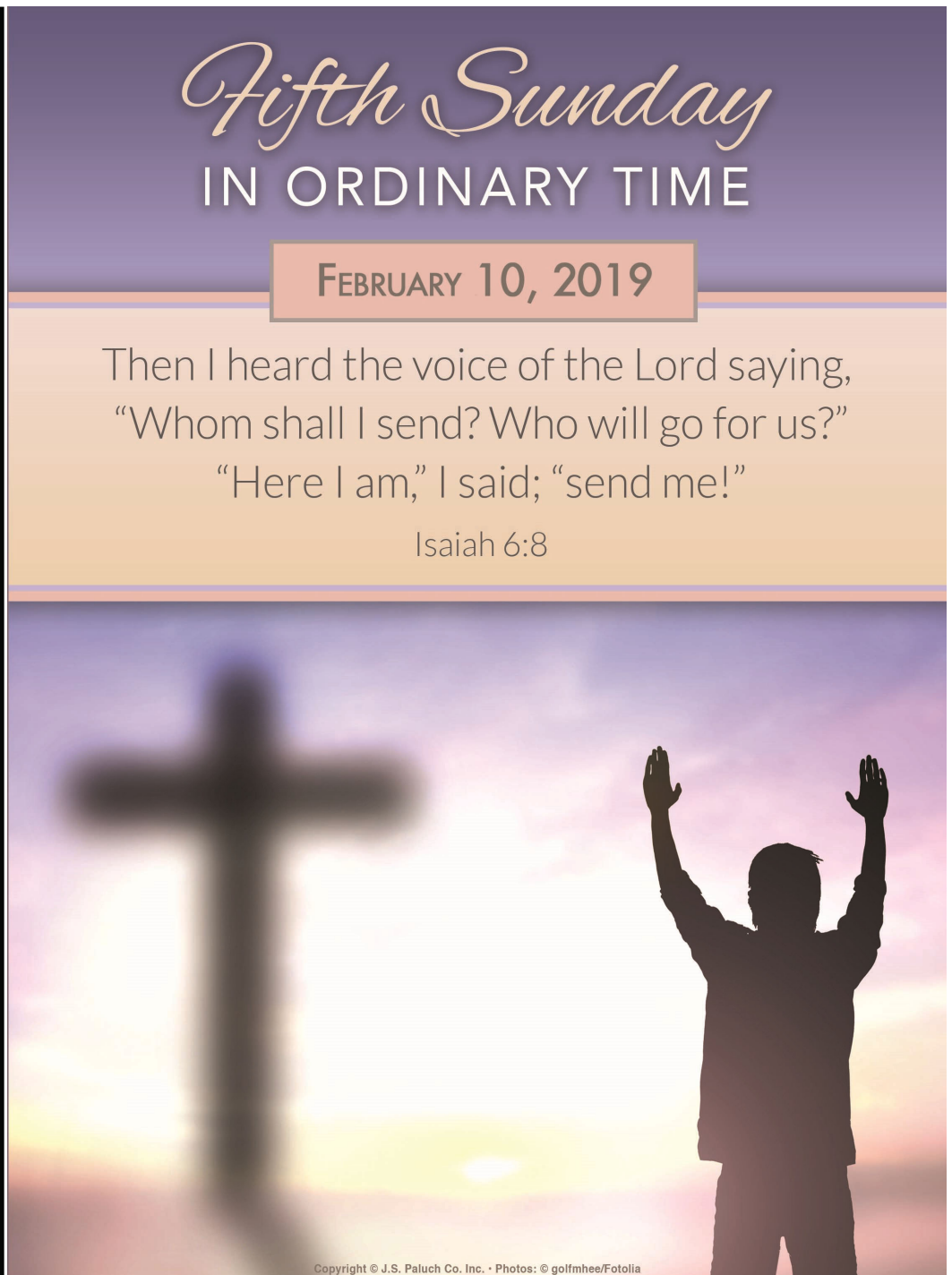

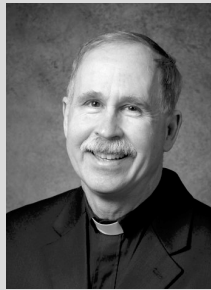

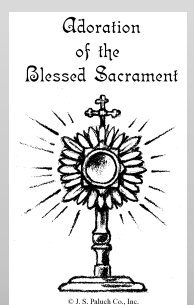

I hope that our families are signing up for our Living the Eucharist program this weekend. I am excited to be in a small group and be able to learn more about the Gospel and my faith.

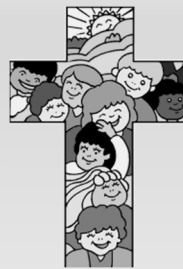

News from 6th grade

Second Semester has been off to a great start for the 6th graders. We have been working very hard and diving into several interesting topics! 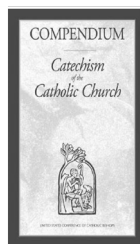

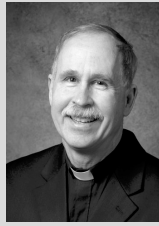

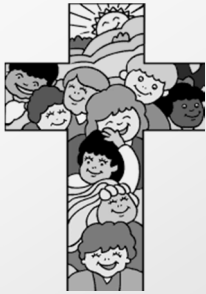
