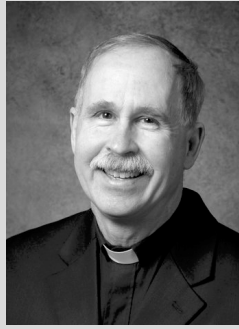

The 8th graders were especially grateful for the opportunities for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Reconciliation at the end of their retreat. Currently, the 8th graders are writing their essays on their Confirmation saint. 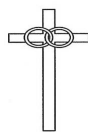

- Communicate your love and respect with your tone of voice and facial expressions.

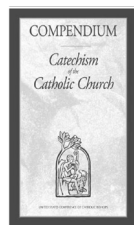

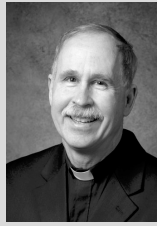

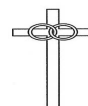
