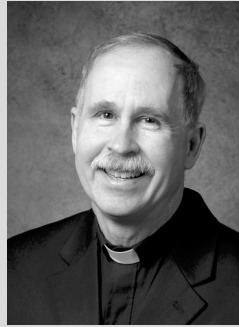

We are headed into spring break. I pray all our students have a safe and restful break.~Dr. Hopson



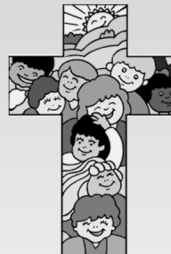
