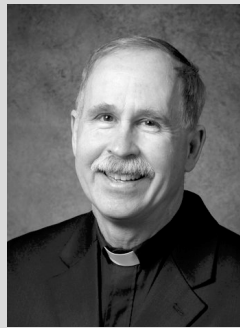

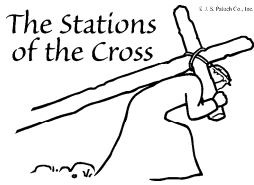

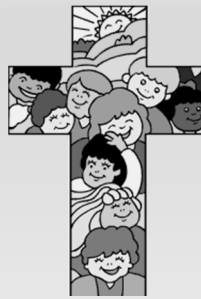
Kindergarten News

These five and six year olds have really learned the meaning of flexibility this past quarter. Although our school schedule was a bit inconsistent during third quarter, we persevered and were able to have some really great learning opportunities about God’s creation of the Earth and the weather patterns of the Winter season. We discussed the beautiful design of the Water Cycle and even created our very own miniature versions using water, blue dye and Ziploc baggies. I am confident this particular group of students understand the forms of precipitation especially since we were given so many hands-on learning opportunities.

Being able to share our Faith within our classrooms is always a special gift. These young minds are so curious about everything that surrounds them and their hearts are so pure. Our discussions include that Lent is a time for us to become better people. We use a butterfly as a symbol during Lent because caterpillars grow and blossom into beautiful butterflies. This is used as a parallel with the life of Jesus, His death and His resurrection. We are fortunate enough to see this transformation with real caterpillars evolving into beautiful butterflies right before the Easter triduum. Their Lenten promises are always so sweet and meaningful. A popular sacrifice or promise is giving up candy and to see a young child refraining from sweets is amazing to see their love for Christ at such a young age. We are excited to see what Spring brings in our last quarter together as a class!

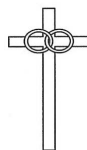

We act the same way when we:

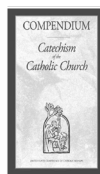
- Take our spouse's faults out of context

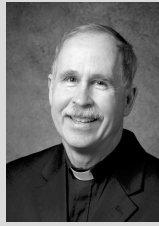
Catechism Corner
