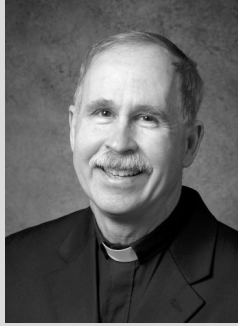

1st grade News

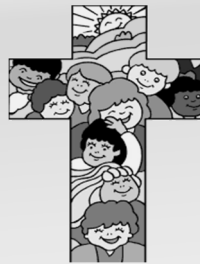

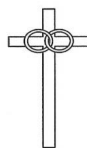

- Remember how Christ desires reconciliation and ask for His help

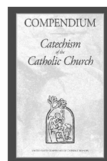

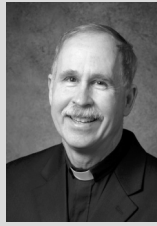


Why are the missions of the Son and the Holy Spirit inseparable?

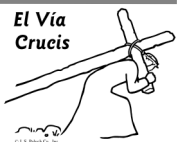
