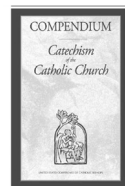
**Stewardship Reflection April 7, 2019**

*What are the names of the Holy Spirit?*

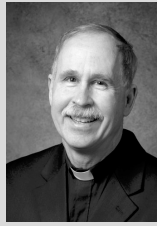

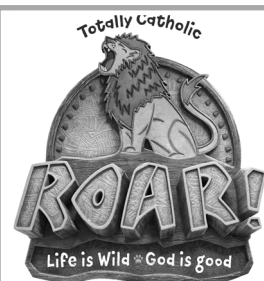
