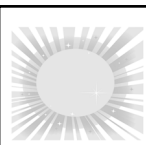
The parish office will be closed on April 22 for Easter Monday. Regular office hours will resume on April 23, 2019.

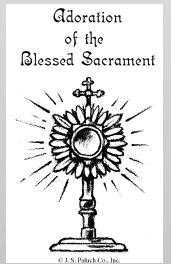

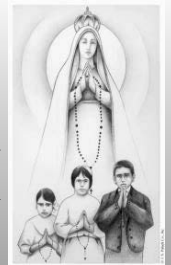

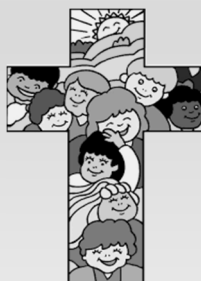
4th Grade News

What do “Number the Stars”, the Holocaust, the Dust Bowl, the water cycle, butterflies, seed germination, and composts have in common? Catholic Social Teaching and the Resurrection, of course! The fourth graders are learning that no matter which subject they study or which way they turn, there is a Catholic Social Teaching principle ready to be studied and lived or a mini-resurrection to behold. As they learn about Ellis Island, study the Underground Railroad, discuss the Japanese Internment Camps of WWII and read “Number the Stars,” (an historical fiction novel set in World War II Denmark) they wrestle with how nations and individuals live the principle of Dignity of the Human Person. A study of soil (which included edible dirt cups), erosion, and the Dust Bowl bring up the principle of Care of Creation. As they watch caterpillars create chrysalises, observe seeds germinate, create composts, and study the water cycle they are reminded that we are surrounded by mini-resurrections. God created a world that moves through and is transformed by cycles. When we recognize this in the natural world the resurrection simply makes sense. The God who created life conquers death and greets us with open arms at the eternal banquet in heaven. How good our God is. How lucky we are at Holy Cross School to be able to openly proclaim The Truth!



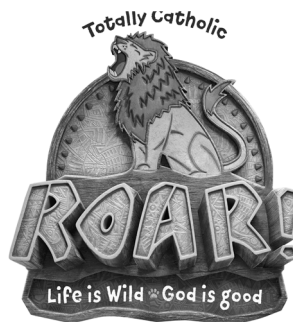

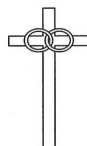

- Choose to courageously witness the beauty of marriage even though friends or extended family may not understand our vocation.

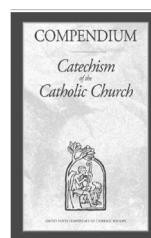

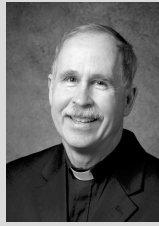
What does it mean that the Spirit "has spoken through the prophets"?

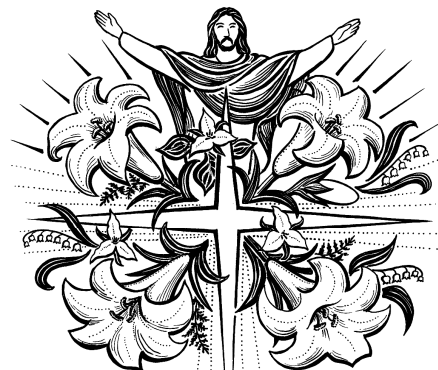

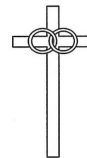
