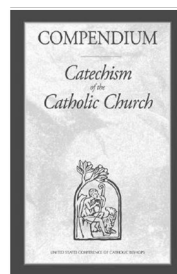
Stewardship Reflection April 28, 2019

What did the Holy Spirit accomplish in John the Baptist?



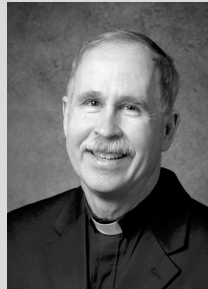

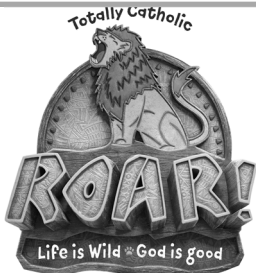

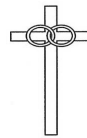

Minuto de Matrimonio



¿Cómo puede la Pascua impactar tu matrimonio?

Después del sacrificio de la Cuaresma y la penumbra de la Semana Santa, a veces podemos llegar a la Pascua como alguien que ha terminado una tarea temida, y reanudamos la vida regularmente programada. Sin embargo, si este es nuestro enfoque, echamos de menos el regalo que la Pascua puede ser para nuestros matrimonios.

El primer mensaje de la Resurrección es “¡No tengas miedo!” Esta frase es proclamada a todos los que se acercan a la tumba vacía, y también a nosotros como personas casadas. No debemos tener miedo:

- ... de enfermedades graves, problemas financieros o en la relación. Él ha vencido incluso a la muerte, por lo que puede sacar el bien de cualquier mal que enfrentemos.
- ... de enfrentar nuestro pecado o el de nuestro cónyuge. Amó a sus discípulos después de que lo abandonaron. Él puede ayudarnos a amarnos con ese mismo amor.
