- A way to make decisions while preserving a tender atmosphere.

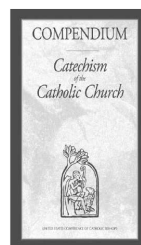

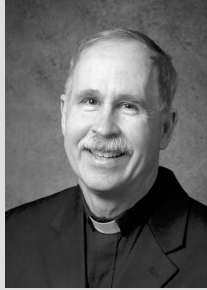


*What is the work of the Spirit in Mary?*

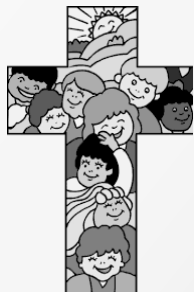

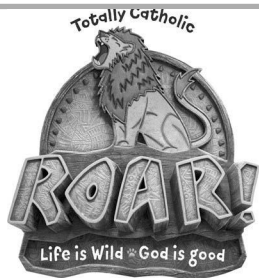

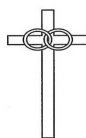
