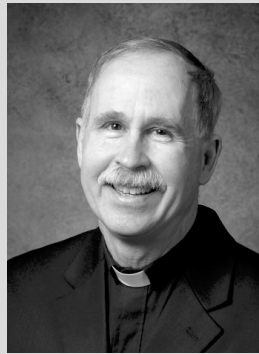

6th Grade News

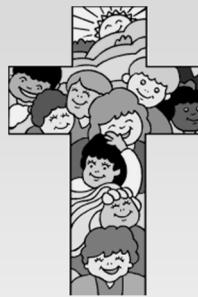
We have been working very hard in 6th grade! In religion, we are discussing the Annunciation and Visitation. We are finishing up the Old Testament and discussing events that have been foreshadowed that will happen in the New Testament. In Social Studies, we have just started our Medieval Europe castle Projects. Students will be researching, making a blueprint and creating a 3-D model of a medieval castle. We will present these in class. In science, we are on our last chapter, *Volcanoes!* Students will soon be getting their final end of the year project where they will be making their very own volcano. In English, we have just started our second literature circle book clubs. Students work hard to discuss and ask questions while reading a book together. They are doing a great job coming up with questions that bring them deeper into the content of the book. In math, we are exploring God's creations of three dimensional figures. We are learning about surface area, volume, and applying these topics to real world situations. The students are currently using their creativity to create a unique project displaying their knowledge of 3-D figures. Some students are making posters, others are making videos, and some are even writing songs! It has been a wonderful year in 6th grade! The students have worked incredibly hard and have grown in their faith and leadership skills.

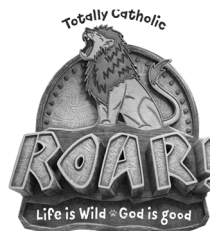

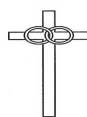

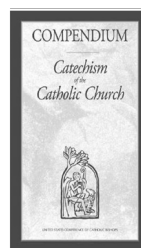

Catechism Corner

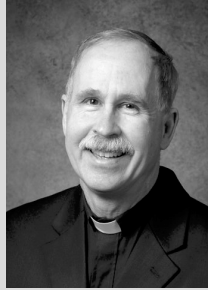


What is the relationship between the Spirit and Christ Jesus in his earthly mission?

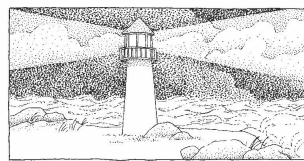

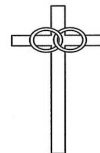
