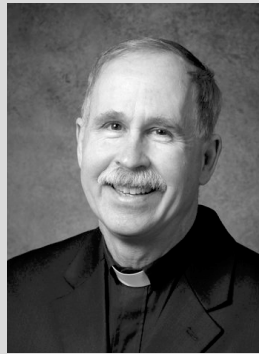

7th Grade News

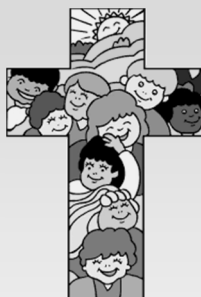

Stewardship Reflection May 19, 2019

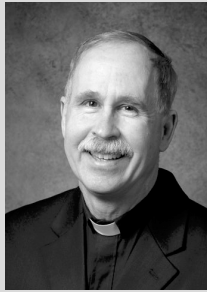

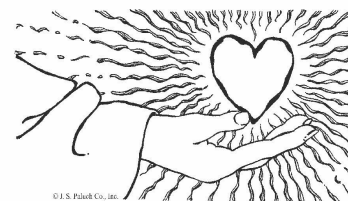

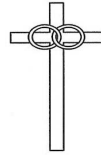
