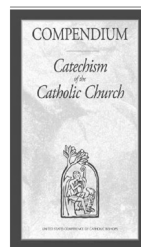
- Start with the assumption that the Church wants the best for its married couples.

**Catechism Corner****What does the Spirit do in the Church?**

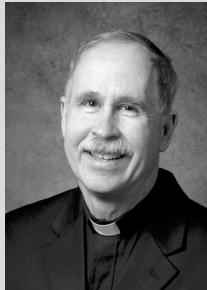

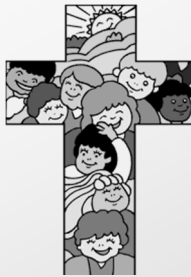

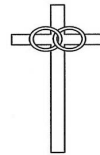
