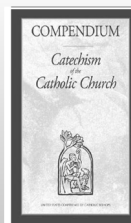
Stewardship Reflection

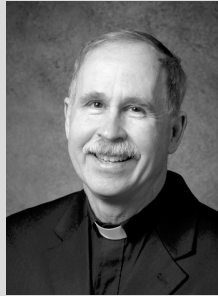


Why is the Church apostolic?

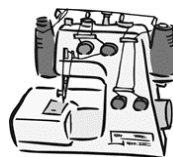

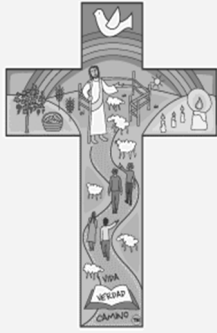
