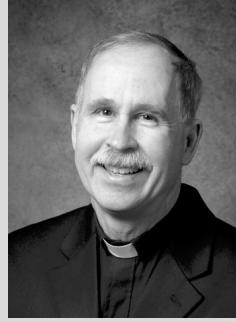

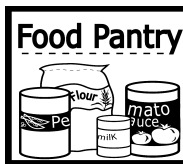

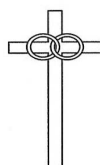
November is Adoption Awareness Month

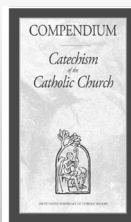
Stewardship Reflection

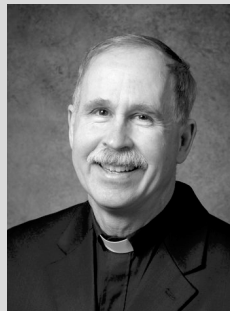


Who are the faithful?

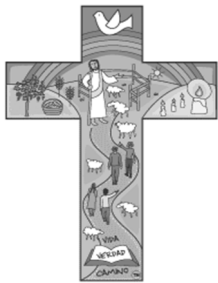

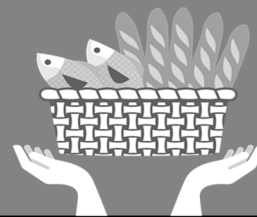
