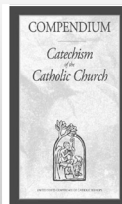
*“You too must be patient. Make your hearts firm, because the coming of the Lord is at hand.” (James 5:8)*

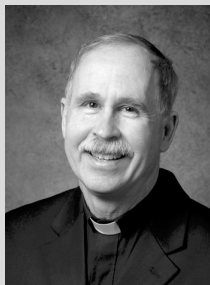
*How is the collegial dimension of Church ministry carried out?*

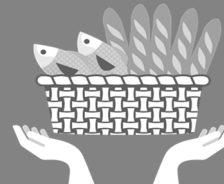
