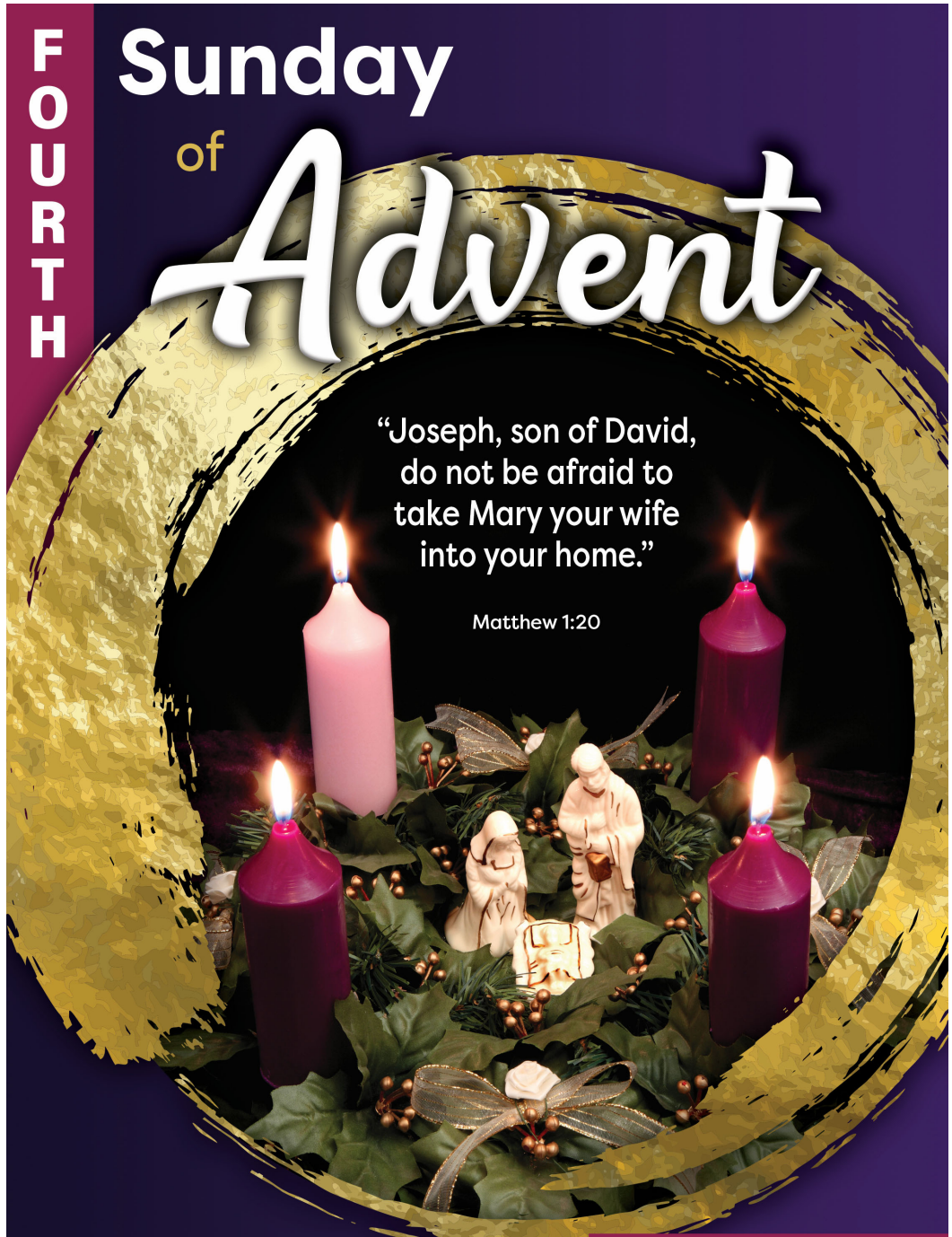

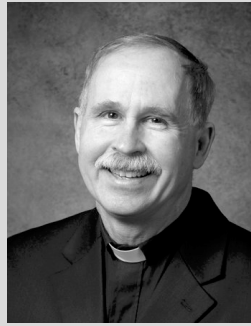

**News from 2nd grade**

When will we receive our sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion? This is the big question on the minds of second graders! The students are so excited to grow in truth, beauty, and goodness, and to become more fully participants in their own faith journey and to join in the mass on a deeper level. Second graders are spending time with their friend, Jesus, everyday, and learning that to be a real friend, there must be time spent together.

During this season of Advent, second graders are learning to reach out to others. It is important to share Jesus with everyone we meet, every day. Others should know that we are followers of Christ, not only in the way we speak to each other, and the words we choose to use, but also in our actions. Second graders greet each other in the morning, help others on the playground, and give others a seat in the cafeteria. These simple daily acts help to grow compassion, understanding, and concern for others.

In second grade, after each mass, second graders are learning to write down what they learn about during the mass. Concentrating during mass, focusing on the message of the priest, and being able to explain in writing how that message may be played out in their own lives shows they grasp that message. 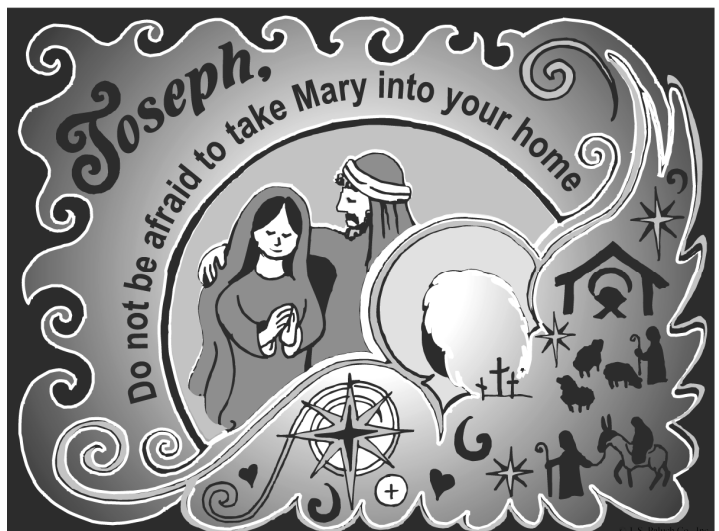

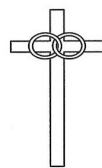

By entering deeply into our spouse's reality, we shine brightly like the Star of Bethlehem, guiding people to the love of God.

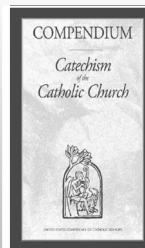
