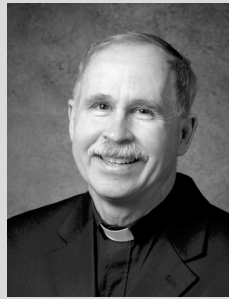

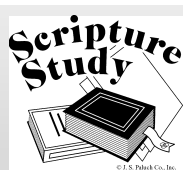

This year, we transitioned from using DELL personal laptops to Google Chromebooks. Chromebook features are constantly changing to serve the needs of our students. 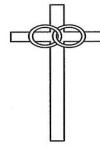

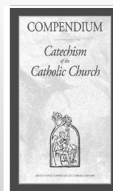
- Do we make decisions about the children together?

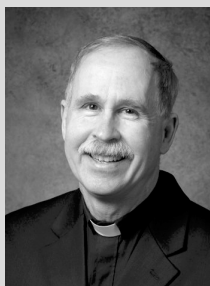
Catechism Corner

A bishop to whom a particular Church has been entrusted governs that Church with the authority of his own sacred power which is ordinary and immediate and exercised in the name of Christ, the Good Shepherd, in communion with the entire Church and under the guidance of the Successor of Peter. 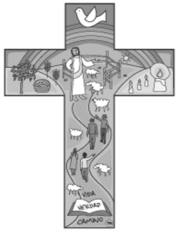

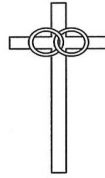
