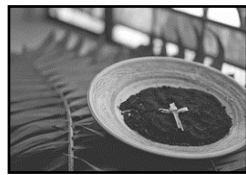

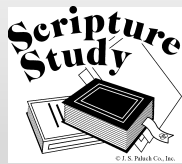


Small group Living the Eucharist books can be picked up after masses the week-end of February 22 - 23 and the week-end of February 29 - March

**News from 7th Grade**

We are very busy this quarter in 7th grade! Students just finished up presenting speeches about "What Freedom Means" to them. The primary source used in researching the topic was Pope John Paul II's writings on freedom. It was such a blessing to hear the students thoughts and feelings on what makes freedom meaningful to them, and at the same time reflecting on why God gave us the freedoms we have, and our responsibility to use our freedoms to serve God. In math, the 7th graders are wrapping up a unit on using percents. This unit included an introduction to personal finance, and the students got to work with tax, tip, commission, interest, and percent increase and decrease. Students got the opportunity to use what they learned in various real-world scenarios. Students are also continuing their confirmation preparations in Religion, and discovering God's plan for them.

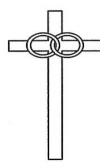

In marriage, we rob ourselves of God's joy when we look to do the minimum for our beloved. To fight this temptation, try:

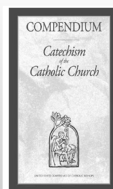
- A marriage retreat

**Stewardship Reflection February 16, 2020**

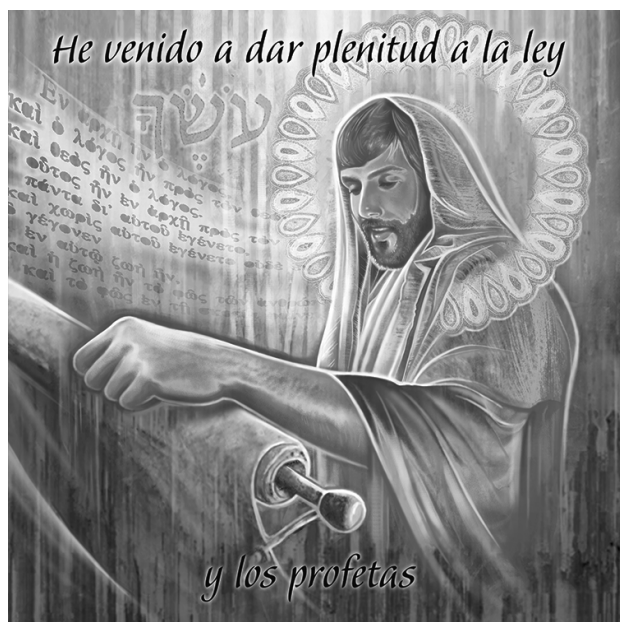
*For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 5:20)*

The scribes and Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law, and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it's the love that you have in your heart that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules out of obligation, not love, does not put you on the path to heaven. Attending Mass on Sunday and then gossiping about a fellow parishioner on the parking lot is an example of a modern day Pharisee.

*How does the laity participate in the prophetic office?*

They participate in it by welcoming evermore in faith the Word of Christ and proclaiming it to the world by the witness of their lives, their words, their evangelizing action, and by catechesis.
