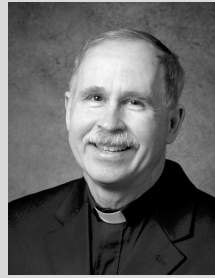

Growing in Truth, Beauty and Goodness

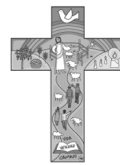


Some ask why move towards a Classical curriculum and method of teaching. We want to not only teach our children to be excellent test takers, more importantly we want to lead students to discover that knowledge and truth are ordered and coherent. This is often called “leadership education” because it builds the skills needed for Catholic leadership in today’s world: logic, debate, theology, knowledge of the Bible, public speaking, clear reasoning, researching, writing, and communicating. When you think about the way that we communicate today (blogs, social media, newspapers etc.) it is clear that one must be able to be persuasive when defending one’s position and have a strong ability to communicate well. These skills are practiced in every subject and prepare students to become leaders in any field they pursue. This is the classical model of education that was used by the great thinkers and leaders of the past, including Aristotle, Plato, C.S. Lewis, and Thomas Jefferson.

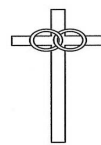
Emergency Response Team-CPR and AED Spring Practice Sessions

- Decide together how to love the person appropriately (even if they won't like it)!

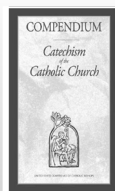

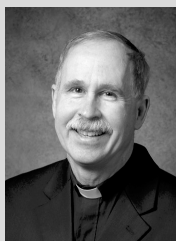


How do the lay faithful participate in the priestly office of Christ?
