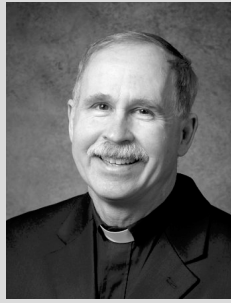

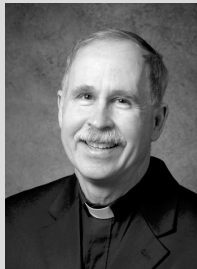
Stewardship Reflection April 12, 2020
